Thank you for planning to attend the **Blue Angels Homecoming Air Show** as the guest of Castrol Aviator/AirBP, Goulian Aerosports and Santex! We look forward to meeting you.

Cancellation:

Due to the popularity of this air show we will have a waiting list for tickets to our chalet. If you need to cancel at the last minute for any reason, please call me so that I can call on my waiting list. My cell: 617-283-2464. Thank you!

Registration:

Be sure to leave early, as there will be traffic. Please plan to arrive no later than 9am so that you have time to park and get to the Air Operations Building on the ramp. You will be parking in "General Parking". There is a short walk to the Air Operations Building (2nd floor conference room) and the ramp. See map. Our business discussion starts at 9:30am in the Air Ops Building. Refer to directions to this building below. Your family or friends may proceed directly to the air show ramp and to the chalet while you attend the business discussion.

At the business discussion, you will meet Jason Vallier from AirBP and Lance Skovsgard from Santex who will be giving the oil seminar and reviewing their product line and wonderful programs with you.

Castrol's "Aviator Chalet":

While you are at the meeting, your family is welcome to proceed to our chalet on the flight line. When you arrive at the chalet, everyone will receive a badge and credentials so that you can come and go throughout the day. I will review the day's schedule and make sure that you know where to get drinks, food, and anything else you may need.

I will be wearing a name badge and red shirt with a "Castrol Aviator" logo on it so that you can find me when you arrive.

The chalet will have hot coffee and cold beverages available all day (water, soda, beer) and we will serve a fully catered lunch. It will also offer you a great place to see the show! All of this is free to you, of course.

If you are driving:

We recommend taking I-10 to the Pine Forest Road exit 7 (Rt 297 south). Merge onto Mobile Hwy for .9 miles. Take a RIGHT onto Saufley Field Road (CR-296) then take a LEFT onto Blue Angel Parkway south all they way to the West gate (also called the back gate). This will take you to General Parking. There will be signs. See map in this document for more detail.

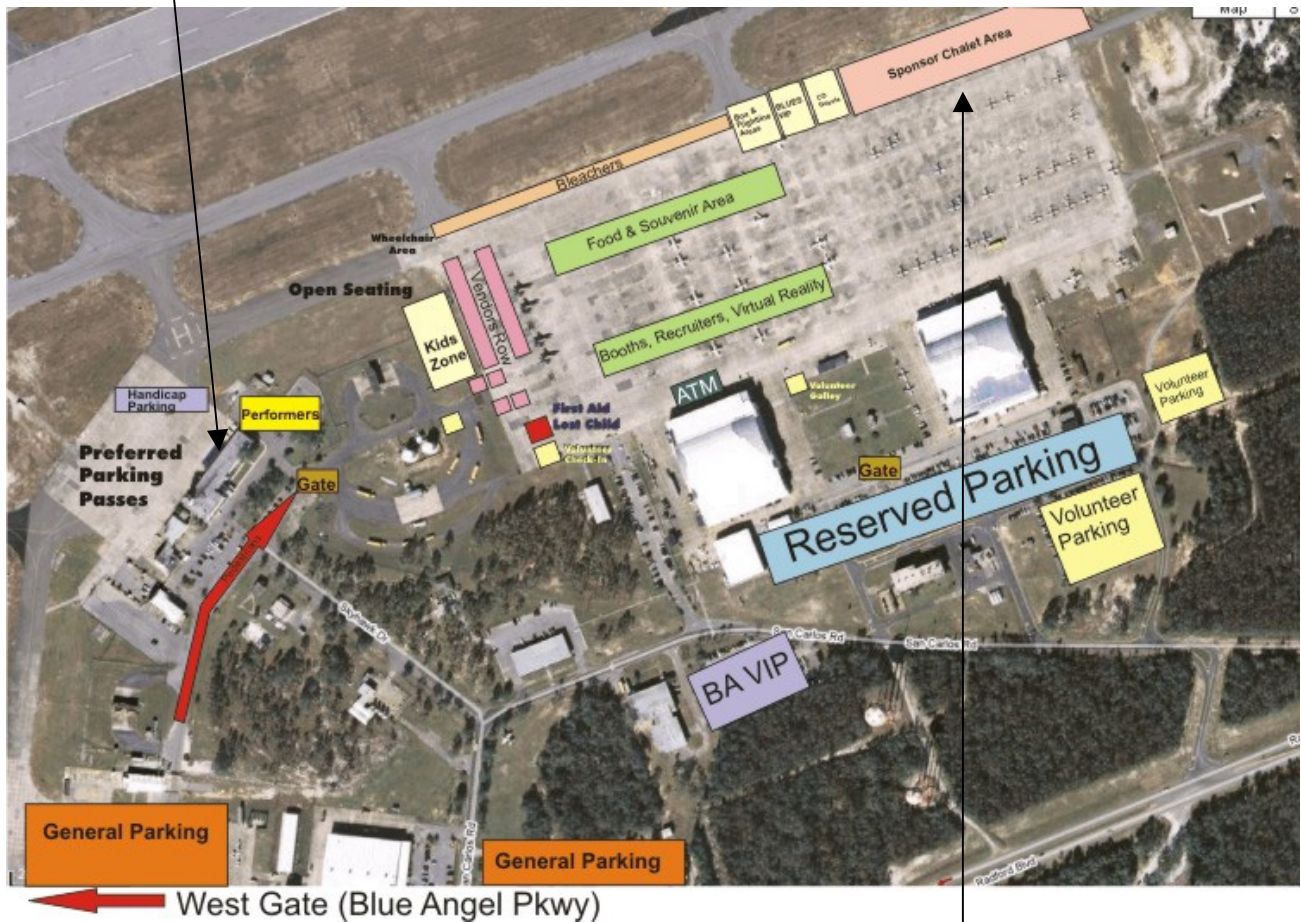

LOCATION OF BUSINESS DISCUSSION in Air Operations Building #1852:



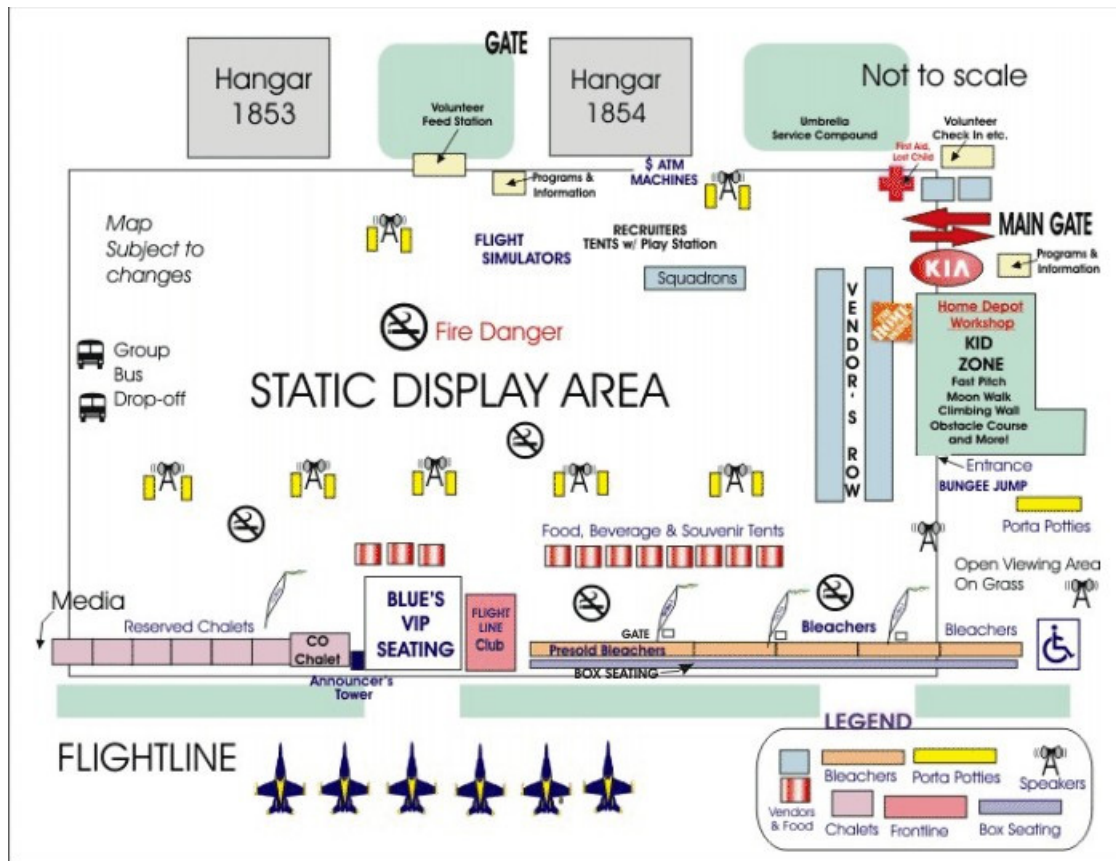
Location of Castrol Aviator Chalet
