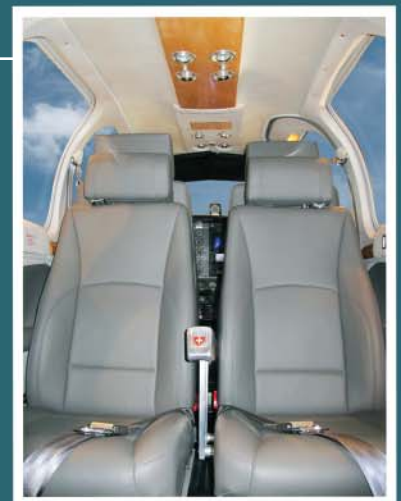

AVIDYNE EQUIPPED



Since we use our aircraft as a part of our business, we sometimes have to fly when the weather is less desirable and in heavily congested airspace. To increase our level of safety in regards to weather avoidance and situational awareness in congested airspace, we turned to Avidyne for the solution. Their EX600 Multi-Function Display (MFD) is the only MFD we found that provides the complete picture “at a glance” – moving map of our flight plan, overlaid weather, lightning detection, airspace, traffic and terrain – all on one page. Avidyne’s EX600 MFD works seamlessly with the Garmin GNS400 or 500 series of GPS units. Coupled with the MFD are the MLB700 Weather/SIRIUS® Satellite Radio Receiver and TAS620 Traffic system. We can also access all of our Jeppesen charts in just a couple of clicks.

HARTZELL “TOP PROP”



To increase our climb and cruise performance, we installed a new Hartzell Scimitar propeller from their famous “Top Prop” conversion program. Designed to optimize performance across the board while maintaining an uncharacteristically low noise signature, the “blended airfoil” Scimitar propeller was my first choice. The result of years of propulsion experience, which includes NASA’s Advanced General Aviation Experiments Program (AGATE), this propeller is a true product of the new millennium. It combines all the features you’ve come to expect from Hartzell compact propellers with a next generation airfoil that maximizes take-off, climb, and cruise thrust, improves cooling, complies with the tough new noise standards of the worlds’ aviation authorities, and looks great in the process. www.HartzellProp.com
